

What are the entry requirements?

Volunteers must meet the following entry requirements:

1. Direct project beneficiaries are excluded as volunteering candidates.
2. The team reserves the right of admission to the volunteer programme.
3. Respond with commitment and responsibility.
4. Be in the emotional, physical and legal conditions required for each action.
5. Respect the confidentiality of the information you handle.
6. Be open, flexible, positive and empathetic towards the people to volunteer with.
7. Special attention should be paid to health and safety issues.
8. Willingness to learn, participate, share and interact with the team.

Any person who participates in the Barrios Orquestados volunteer scheme must prove that they are not convicted of crimes against freedom, sexual indemnity, trafficking, and exploitation of minors, as the project involves regular contact with minors.

Each volunteer will be assigned a mentor to supervise attendance records and to hold a monthly meeting to evaluate the degree of compliance with the project's objectives and action plans. There will be also two assessment reviews over the year, every six months, that will be carried out by the work team together with the group of volunteers.
